AN INTRODUCTION INTO THE THOROUGHBRED HORSE INDUSTRY FOR HIGH-SCHOOL STUDENTS

This is a FREE introductory discovery program into the thoroughbred horse industry. Students will learn about numerous career pathways across the industry with a focus on horse-breeding, racing and equine veterinary nursing. Students will also acquire skills through practical training at Scone TAFE in the Hunter Thoroughbred Breeding Centre of Excellence and witness industry activities of interest, followed by an optional work placement experience.

This is a program that may result in part-time employment. Summer job roles include: Assisting at Stables, Foal Watch, Stud Hand, Yearling Sale Preparation, Farm and Garden Crews.

Post-school opportunities include: Traineeships in Horse-Breeding, Racing Stables, Equine Veterinary Nursing, Agriculture and Horticulture.
