The Foaling and Night Watch Course is designed for the person intending to care for and supervise foaling mares.

It concentrates on assessing the normal events of late pregnancy and foaling and assessing the health of newborn foals. Tutorial within the course will also cover foal growth and development, and providing assistance in the initial care of the compromised foal.

This course is open to existing equine breeding industry workforce with a minimum 6 months breeding season experience and assisting with foaling.

Participants are to attend 12 foalings by the end of October if they wish to successfully complete the Foaling unit.
